**Nomination and Election of Process Vegetables NZ
Chairperson and Board Representatives**

Process Vegetables NZ Chairperson and Board representatives are elected by growers, this is your opportunity to have direct input into the election process.

Any grower who has paid a levy to Process Vegetables New Zealand during the past 12 months from 1 April 2018 is eligible to nominate, second a nomination or be nominated for the position of Process Vegetables NZ Chairperson or Board Representative/s.

Positions for Nomination -

Process Vegetables NZ Chairperson

If more than one nomination is received this position will be voted on by postal vote, but otherwise the incumbent will be declared elected at the AGM.

- ❖ **DAVID HADFIELD (CANTERBURY)**, is available for re-election as Chairperson and is deemed to be nominated, and will be re-elected if there are no other nominations.

Process Vegetables NZ Board Representatives

There is an annual retirement by rotation (every 3 years) for Board representatives. Board representatives who are retiring by rotation and are available for re-election **do not** need to be nominated.

Board representatives available for election, are deemed to be nominated and will be elected or re-elected if there is no opposing candidate.

- ❖ **Hugh Ritchie (Hawkes Bay)** - retires by rotation, is available for re-election, is deemed to be nominated and will be re-elected if there is no opposing candidate.
- ❖ **Jim Sim (Canterbury)** - retires by rotation, is available for re-election, is deemed to be nominated and will be re-elected if there is no opposing candidate.

All nominations must be seconded.

Nominations must also be signed by the nominee to confirm they are willing to stand.

Where do I send my nominations?

Nomination forms should be returned to Horticulture New Zealand either by scanning and emailing to Lynda.banks@hortnz.co.nz, or by post to Horticulture New Zealand, PO Box 10232, The Terrace, Wellington 6143.

When do nominations close?

Nominations close at 4:00pm on Wednesday 3 July 2019.

Will there be a vote?

If there are more nominations than positions available, levy paying growers within the Process Vegetables NZ Product Group will be eligible to vote in a postal vote.

WEDNESDAY 24 JULY	VOTING CLOSES
WEDNESDAY 31 JULY	RESULTS ANNOUNCED AT THE PROCESS VEGETABLES NZ AGM AT CONFERENCE
